Better understand your exposure to selected metals and other chemicals

The free test will check for metals in your drinking water and metals and other chemicals, such as phthalates (chemicals in plastics) in your body (through a small sample of your urine)

To participate, you must:

- Use a private or shared well for most of your drinking water
- Be willing to provide a sample of drinking water
- Be willing to provide a urine sample
- Complete a brief survey about potential sources of exposure to metals and other chemicals
- Be at least 18 years of age
