NOTICE OF ELECTION**

Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Sections 1-11-1 to 1-11-3, I, Tanya Shelby, San Juan County Clerk, of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby issue the following:

That a Primary Election is hereby called to be held throughout the County of San Juan, State of New Mexico, and in each precinct thereof, on the 2nd day of June 2020; and

That the Primary Election shall be for the purpose of permitting the Democratic Party, the Republican Party, and the Libertarian Party to nominate candidates for the following offices:

ABSENTEE VOTING will be conducted at the San Juan County Clerk's Office, 100 South Oliver Drive, Suite 200, Aztec, New Mexico commencing on Tuesday, May 5, 2020. The last day for the County Clerk's Office to mail an absentee ballot to a voter is Friday, May 29, 2020.

EARLY VOTING will be conducted at the County Clerk's Office, 100 South Oliver Street Ste. 200, Aztec, NM, commencing on Tuesday, May 5, 2020 during regular business hours, 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Beginning Saturday, May 16, 2020, voting hours at the County Clerk's office will be 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday and Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The last day for all Early Voting will be Saturday, May 30, 2020.

EARLY VOTING AT ALTERNATE LOCATIONS will commence on Saturday, May 16, 2020 and end on Saturday, May 30, 2020. The alternate locations and hours are as follows:

TO BE ELIGIBLE to vote in the upcoming Primary Election a qualified elector needed to be registered by May 5, 2020 or a qualified elector may register to vote or update an existing certificate of registration at the County Clerk's office during regular hours and days of operation beginning May 5, 2020 through May 30, 2020. However, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-4-5.7E a voter shall not be allowed to change party affiliation when updating an existing certificate of registration or registering to vote at an early voting site or polling place during a Primary Election
