### MINUTES

September 12, 2025 and September 19, 2025  
11:00 a.m.

1. Meeting called to order by chapter president Harrison LaMone at 11:10 a.m.
2. Invocation was made by Jane Jones and all officials were present but no council delegate Rickie Nez.
3. Reviewed agenda made by Harrison LaMone and one comment by Jona Lapahie Keedah to add a resolution regarding road N5 speeders and too many truckers, no semis needed on N5, creating too many pot holes on recent paved roads. State police needs to be notified to monitor the road. Laverne Begay, a member made a comment. She spoked with the bus driver and the problems the same through out the bus route not just on N5. On N5 yes the semi truckers do not move over no courtesy, especially when the students are being dropped off. KNDN also makes the announcement of speeders, Bus driver transporting students to LaGuna so she won't make it to the meeting. Signs don't help. They'll continue to be wreckless. We need safety for the students. How can this be fixed?

5. Accepting the Last Meeting – August 8, 2025 was read by Secretary Treasurer Theresa Johnson Harrison asked if all is correct, there was no comment from members so it was,  
**Motioned: Jona L Keedah Seconded by: Laverne Begay Vote:16 approved,0 opposed,5 abstain**
6. Guests: Harrison asked if the guests listed are present.
  - a. San Juan County Election: Arlenta Horse-Dickie/Mary Ann Benally, no one was present.
  - b. Kinder Morgan: Sheyenne Love was present along with Victor Dee. They'll make their comments till their resolution is presented.
  - c. Joann Blackwater Begay; Growing in Beauty Early Intervention Program; not present
  - d. Adrian Blueeyes; Harrison mentioned there are two (2) candidates, there's the Kis'an'i lady Deb Halland who was a former Dept of Interior and Sam Bergman. Introduction for NM Governor Campaign for Sam Bregman: Mr Blueeyes introduced himself, his clans, was present and he did a brief presentation on NM Governor candidate, Mr Sam Bergman. He went over the brochure he had and passed out to members and mentioned Mescalero Apache's endorsed him. Harrison also mentioned Mr. Sam Bergman is an attorney.
7. New Business: Harrison went over the resolution and where the pipeline goes through into Burnham boundary. They've visited the site twice. A lot of us members haul water from there. Nageezi, Carson, Delnazini residents also haul water from there. Sheyenne: Introduced, herself but Victor Dee stepped in and did a small presentation of how EPNG pipeline started a long time ago. Many of our people worked for EPNG. Then Kinder Morgan bought EPNG. EPNG is still the parent company. Its currently being in operation and maintained. We traveled on Navajo Nation, has over 300 pipeline. Is a major operation. Theres only two (2) pipelines going through end of Bisti and in operation and onto Gallup and onto Leup. Our visits are only for ROW and Bronsons' very busy on this operation.

**Harrison:** This is for NO pipe removals, it's to only renew ROW. They've already visited Nenahnezad, Newcomb chapters and only Burnham Chapter is left. Questions?

**Jona Keedah,** temporary employee at chapter made a comment and then she read a letter received from Kinder Morgan/ Christine Pratt. (Chapter President, Harrison was supposed to read this but a temporary office aide took over) she complained nowhere in the letter states annual visits, \$16.66 a month how's that to help our students' scholarships. NTEC, APS contributes to the chapter. It doesn't help us with this \$5000, it will end up the chapter paying for everything. Suggest tabling this because the community needs their every answer. I understand Artesian well means a lot to many of you but it doesn't state it on letter. (NOONE seconded)

**Sheyenne:** We're just the middle person, we understand the yearly contribution of APS helping with scholarships. Understand the negotiation was done between that the Finalization is between the Chapter President and director of Kinder Morgan. \$5000 is to help diagnose the Hot water well site. We didn't know it had been evaluated in 2020; we didn't know of prior years diagnosis on the well. Christine is still working with NTUA, Navajo Nation EPA on the well. This renewal expires in October, which is why we're here.

**Victor Dee:** How can we get help? If we were in a new company, they would've been negotiating a ruling to help. But this is already in operation, it remains the same. It is just ROW, nothing's taken out. If a lot of money is to be given the Navajo Nation will need more info why. This is an agreement made back in 1950s. You only have ROW on pipes. Navajo Nation told us the ROW Pipeline is the only thing we're to work on, nothing else we can't be handling pointing to anything else. Yes we understand NTEC does community help. Kinder Morgan's the biggest contributor to the Navajo Nation. You as members should ask your delegate. You should be asking your council delegate why he can't help you? He has the authority to get funds for you. 70 years ago, there was not much going on with ROW way back then but now the Navajo's blocks it. The majority of the chapters accepted this resolution.

**Harrison:** the resolution we have is a template.

**Ray Henry:** you said a letter was received this morning? What does it say?

**Harrison:** it was already read earlier by Jona.

**Ray Henry:** I've seen the map and the pipeline is way over there in Bisti. I would suggest the exposed pipeline should be addressed. The young lady who said lets think over of the resolution. Many of us don't live on the pipeline ROW area. My main concern is Artesian, are you still wanting to fix the problem with the leak.

**Sheyenne:** I don't know what the diagnosis will be.

**Ray Henry:** If we just keep blocking this resolution the problem will remain. The resolution is ready and let them address the exposed pipeline. Even though the wells leaking let it be. If we keep blocking it it won't be fixed. If things goes right if the resolution goes through, the pipelines still there. Years from now, your (directed at Jona) young with a young mind and you should tackle them again with your concern. Let us consider this let us approve it for them. We shouldn't table this, let the resolution be approved. (Still no one second the table, several minutes went by)

**Fannie:** There's several pipelines in the Bisti area, near compressor station, near homesite. The pipeline is ROW and the road is on ROW. The chapter can't even to touch that road, they always say it's a ROW. Maybe Kinder Morgan can work on roads. She went over how the past winter blizzards blocked roads. Every which way we turn Navajo Nation seems blocking it. With Harrison and Christine Pratts meeting, what was discussed? What was included? We need a form of resolution done for what we need for the community.

Officials getting \$500 with no work going forward. (???We're off subject)

Artesian well can easily explode and white rock station needs to be a standby for water. Regarding new companies, 4 corners trade to run a line along N5 , we haven't seen anything/info on this.

(Still no one second the suggested tabling, several minutes went by)

Harrison: mentioned again during planning meeting EPNG we visited the well site.

- **Ray Henry:** can we vote on it now?
- **Harrison:** I need a motion on it now? The resolution will be read to you first and then we'll vote on it.
- **Edison Smith:** point of order, it was tabled already
- **Theresa:** It was not tabled, there was no second.
- **Harrison:** ok we'll motion to table and take a vote.
