Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Sections 1-11-1 to 1-11-3, I, Alyssa Kuhn, San Juan County Clerk, of the State of New Mexico, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby issue the following:

That a Primary Election is hereby called to be held throughout the County of San Juan, State of New Mexico, and in each precinct thereof, on the 2nd day of June 2026; and

The Primary Election shall be for the purpose of permitting the Democratic Party, Republican Party, Declined to State and Minor parties to nominate candidates from the Democratic Party and Republican Party in the following offices:

ABSENTEE VOTING will be conducted at the San Juan County Clerk's Office, 100 South Oliver Drive, Suite 200, Aztec, New Mexico commencing on Tuesday, May 5, 2026. The last day for the County Clerk's Office to mail an absentee ballot to a voter is Tuesday, May 19, 2026.

EARLY VOTING will be conducted at the County Clerk's Office, 100 South Oliver Street Ste. 200, Aztec, NM, commencing on Tuesday, May 5, 2026 during regular business hours, 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Beginning Saturday, May 16, 2026, voting hours at the County Clerk's office will be 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday and Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The last day for all Early Voting will be Saturday, May 30, 2026.



TO BE ELIGIBLE to vote in the upcoming Primary Election a qualified elector needed to be registered by May 5, 2026. However, a qualified elector may register to vote or update an existing certificate of registration at the County Clerk's office during regular hours and days of operation beginning May 5, 2026 through May 30, 2026. A qualified elector may register to vote or update an existing certificate of registration at the County Clerk's Office and at all Alternate Early Voting sites during regular hours and days of operation beginning May 16, 2026 through May 30, 2026. A qualified elector may also register to vote on election day, June 2, 2026 at any of the 33 San Juan County voting convenience centers between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 1-4-5.7E a voter associated with a major party (Democratic or Republican) shall not be allowed to change party affiliation when updating an existing certificate of registration or registering to vote at an early voting site or polling place during a Primary Election. However, all Declined to State and minor party voters are eligible to vote in this election by simply choosing a Democratic or Republican ballot. If voters are registered as qualified minor party affiliations (Libertarian and Green) they are not eligible to vote in this election unless they change their party affiliation through Same Day Registration.
